Last year, our church established the **Mission Sending and Church Planting** account. This account was established to do two things...

FIRST, assist our people who feel God calling them to engage in mission efforts longer than a regular one or two week trip. In many cases, these men and women head out to the mission field for one or two years at a time. Currently, we are assisting Andrea Moore in Germany and we are praying with another couple about embarking on their venture.

SECOND, this fund is used to help plant churches in our country and across our borders. Currently, we are assisting with three church plants...East Nashville, Las Conchas, Guatemala and Bruhl, Germany.

So, just know that when you give each Sunday, 2 1/2 cents of every dollar goes toward our people who seek to be used by God to spread the Gospel on a mission field.
