Scholarship Program

GUIDELINES

revised May 2007

1. The intent of this scholarship is to assist students who are attending Southern Baptist Institutions or furthering their education with the intent toward full-time church related vocation.
2. Scholarship money shall be awarded from the annual budget allocations as well as interest derived from an established account, The Richard Herrington Scholarship Memorial Fund, through which individual donations may be made.
3. Each application shall be evaluated on its own merits at the time of the application. The Missions Team reserves the right to wave scholarship guidelines based on individual circumstances.
4. Eligible, part-time students applying for this scholarship will be considered on an individual basis.
5. A Scholarship File shall be established in the Church Office. The Missions Team working with the Church Financial Secretary shall update and maintain this file. Applications will be available in this file.
6. The Missions Team Chairman shall appoint three serving mission team members to serve on a Scholarship Subteam. This Subteam shall also include the Student Pastor.
7. The Scholarship application will be reviewed and the scholarship administered by the Missions Team. The Scholarship Subteam reserves the right to interview each qualified applicant before the initial scholarship is awarded and may require future interviews at their discretion. An updated transcript for each renewal will be required.
8. The Missions Team may award as many scholarships as is deemed appropriate in a church year and as funds permit.
9. No student shall receive more than \$1000.00 in any church year. Financial need of the applicant shall be taken into consideration when awards are made.
10. The scholarship will be paid to the institution for tuition and/or board. Applicants will be eligible to apply for this scholarship at the beginning of their freshman year.
11. The dates for applying for scholarships will be advertised in Church Media. Applications must be returned to the Missions Team or Church Office by advertised deadline dates. It will be the responsibility of the applying student to check for these dates.
12. Applicant must be an active member of Hermitage Hills Baptist Church for at least one year at the time of the initial application for the scholarship. Applicant must show evidence of interest and regular participation in church programs. Letters supporting this participation will be required from a Pastor and another person in Church Leadership with their application. Hermitage Hills Baptist Church encourages all students to become a member of a local Southern Baptist Church in their college area.
13. A person applying for this scholarship must have a 2.6 average (out of 4.0 or its equivalent in a different grading system) and maintain that average to be eligible to reapply. If a person wishes to apply for a seminary diploma program, this requirement may be waived at the initial application.
